



Day 1: Arrival in Jaipur and Easy Start with Sightseeing

- **Albert Hall Museum:** Start the afternoon with a visit to the Albert Hall Museum, Jaipur's oldest museum, featuring a diverse collection of artifacts like ancient sculptures, paintings, textiles, and more.
- **Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds):** Stop by the iconic Hawa Mahal, an architectural marvel with 953 small windows, allowing a cool breeze to circulate within the palace—a true spectacle of the Pink City.
- **Leisurely Evening Market Stroll:** Conclude the day with a relaxed walk through Johari Bazaar, Jaipur's famous jewelry market, to browse traditional Rajasthani handicrafts, jewelry, and textiles.

Day 2: Jaipur Full-Day Sightseeing – Forts, Palaces, and Traditional Arts

- **Amer Fort:** Begin the day with a trip to the historic Amer Fort, where they can take a scenic jeep or elephant ride up to the fort. Inside, your client will explore the beautiful Sheesh Mahal (Mirror Palace), Diwan-e-Khas, and the tranquil Sukh Niwas with its water channels.
- **Jaigarh Fort:** Head to Jaigarh Fort next, known for its massive cannons and panoramic views of Jaipur. The fort's museum offers a glimpse into Rajasthan's military history.
- **Lunch Break:** Enjoy traditional Rajasthani cuisine at a local restaurant.
- **City Palace:** After lunch, visit the grand City Palace complex, known for its blend of Mughal and Rajasthani architecture. Highlights include the Mubarak Mahal, Chandra Mahal (still home to Jaipur's royal family), and museums showcasing royal artifacts and textiles.
- **Jantar Mantar:** Visit this UNESCO-listed astronomical observatory, housing instruments for measuring time and tracking celestial bodies.
- **Nahargarh Fort:** For a memorable finish, go to Nahargarh Fort for stunning sunset views over Jaipur. The fort's location on the Aravalli Hills offers breathtaking cityscapes.
- **Overnight Stay:** Jaipur

Day 3: Jaipur to Udaipur via Kishangarh Dumpyard and Lake Pichola

- **Departure for Udaipur:** After breakfast, begin the journey to Udaipur, with a scenic stop at the Kishangarh Dumpyard en route.
- **Kishangarh Dumpyard:** This surprising spot is famous for its surreal, moon-like landscape created by marble slurry—a unique spot for photographs.
- **Arrival in Udaipur and Check-In:** Arrive in Udaipur and check in to the hotel, with some time to relax.
- **Lake Pichola Boat Ride:** In the evening, enjoy a peaceful boat ride on Lake Pichola, with views of the serene Jag Mandir and Lake Palace.

- **Bagore Ki Haveli:** In the late afternoon, explore this historic haveli, which houses artifacts from Rajasthan's royal heritage. In the evening, enjoy a lively cultural performance with folk music and dance.

Day 5: Udaipur to Jodhpur via Haldi Ghati and Kumbhalgarh Fort

- **Haldi Ghati:** After breakfast, start the journey toward Jodhpur with a stop at Haldi Ghati, a historic battlefield site where Maharana Pratap fought a legendary battle.
- **Kumbhalgarh Fort:** Visit Kumbhalgarh Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The massive fort walls span 36 kilometers, second only to the Great Wall of China. Explore the fort’s temples and palaces and enjoy breathtaking views.
- **Arrival in Jodhpur and Check-In:** Arrive in Jodhpur in the evening and check into a Heritage Haveli to enjoy authentic Rajasthani ambiance.
- **Overnight Stay:** Jodhpur

Day 6: Jodhpur Local Sightseeing and Transfer to Jaisalmer

- **Mehrangarh Fort:** Start with Mehrangarh Fort, one of India’s largest and most impressive forts, featuring palaces, museums, and expansive courtyards. The fort offers spectacular views of the Blue City.
- **Jaswant Thada:** Visit this beautiful marble cenotaph, built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh, surrounded by lush gardens.
- **Umaid Bhawan Palace:** Explore this opulent palace that now serves as both a museum and luxury hotel.
- **Departure for Jaisalmer:** In the afternoon, drive to Jaisalmer and check in at a heritage hotel within Jaisalmer Fort for a truly unique experience.
- **Overnight Stay:** Jaisalmer

Day 7: Jaisalmer Local Sightseeing, Gadisar Lake, Kuldhara Village, and Desert Camp

- **Gadisar Lake:** Begin with a visit to Gadisar Lake, a beautiful spot with temples and ghats surrounding it.
- **Historic Havelis:** Explore Jaisalmer’s famous havelis, including Patwon Ki Haveli, Salim Singh Ki Haveli, and Nathmal Ki Haveli, known for their distinctive Rajasthani architecture.
- **Bada Bagh:** Visit this tranquil garden complex with royal cenotaphs dedicated to the rulers of Jaisalmer.
- **Kuldhara Village:** Next, visit the abandoned village of Kuldhara, known for its mysterious atmosphere and legends of being cursed.
- **Sam Sand Dunes Desert Camp:** In the evening, head to the Sam Sand Dunes for a desert camp experience. Enjoy a camel ride to catch the sunset over the dunes, followed by a cultural night with Rajasthani folk music, dance, and dinner under the stars.
- **Overnight Stay:** Desert Camp, Jaisalmer

Day 8: Departure from Jaisalmer to Jodhpur Railway Station

- **Breakfast and Departure:** Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the camp. After checking out, embark on the journey back to Jodhpur.
