



6 DAYS MEGHALAYA ITINERARY

Guwahati • Shillong • Cherrapunji • Dawki • Mawlynnong • Shnongpdeng

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN GUWAHATI → SHILLONG

Welcome to Northeast India!

On arrival at **Guwahati Airport/Railway Station**, you will be welcomed by your private chauffeur and begin your journey towards **Shillong**, the capital of Meghalaya.

As you leave Guwahati, the landscape gradually changes from the plains of Assam to the lush green hills of Meghalaya.

Umiam Lake

En route, make a stop at **Umiam Lake**, one of Meghalaya's most scenic and recognisable landscapes.

Spend some time enjoying the panoramic views of the lake and surrounding hills and take a few photographs.

Continue towards Shillong and check in to your hotel.

If time permits, you may explore **Police Bazaar** in the evening or simply relax at the hotel after the journey.

DAY 2: SHILLONG LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, proceed for a full day of sightseeing around Shillong.

Shillong Peak

Begin your day with a visit to **Shillong Peak**, one of the city's popular viewpoints.

On a clear day, enjoy panoramic views of Shillong and the surrounding hills. Visibility can vary considerably depending on cloud cover and weather conditions.

DAY 3: SHILLONG → CHERRAPUNJI → LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, check out from your Shillong hotel and begin your scenic journey towards **Cherrapunji, also known as Sohra**.

The route itself is one of the highlights of Meghalaya, taking you through green hills, winding roads and dramatic valleys.

Mawkdok Dympep Valley Viewpoint

Make a stop at **Mawkdok Dympep Valley** and enjoy panoramic views of the surrounding landscape.

Nohkalikai Falls

Continue to **Nohkalikai Falls**, one of Meghalaya's most famous waterfalls.

Enjoy the spectacular viewpoint overlooking the waterfall and valley.

Seven Sisters Falls

Visit the viewpoint of **Seven Sisters Falls**, another iconic attraction around Cherrapunji.

During the rainy season, the falls can be particularly impressive, although visibility depends on the weather.

Mawsmmai Cave

Explore **Mawsmmai Cave**, a natural limestone cave near Cherrapunji.

Some sections are narrow and uneven, so comfortable walking shoes are recommended.

After sightseeing, proceed to your hotel and check in.

Spend the evening relaxing and enjoying the peaceful surroundings of Sohra.

DAY 5: CHERRAPUNJI → DAWKI → MAWLYNNONG → SHNONGPDENG

After breakfast, check out and begin your journey towards the eastern part of Meghalaya.

Today combines **Dawki, Mawlynnong and Shnongpdeng**.

Dawki & Umngot River

Arrive in **Dawki**, located close to the India-Bangladesh border.

The main attraction is the **Umngot River**, known for its scenic landscape and clear water during favourable conditions.

If weather, water levels and local safety conditions permit, you may enjoy a boat ride on the river.

Important: The famous crystal-clear appearance of the Umngot River is seasonal. During the monsoon or after heavy rainfall, the river can become considerably less transparent.

India-Bangladesh Border

Depending on local conditions and the available time, you may also visit the border area around Dawki.

Please follow all local instructions and restrictions in the area.

Mawlynnong

Continue towards **Mawlynnong**, a picturesque village known for its cleanliness and community-led environmental practices.

Spend some time exploring the village and enjoying its peaceful surroundings.

Riwai Living Root Bridge

Visit the nearby **Riwai Living Root Bridge**.

Compared with the Double Decker Living Root Bridge at Nongriat, this is much easier to access and provides an opportunity to experience Meghalaya's unique living-root bridge tradition without undertaking a demanding trek.

Continue to Shnongpdeng
